Diploma in Retail Operations Management provides students with the appropriate knowledge and skills to become a retail industry specialist. Students will undergo five (5) semesters programme inclusive of two (2) semester work-based learning. The courses in this programme are selected according to the current needs of industry. The discipline courses cover the technical aspects of retail and business knowledge. In addition to those courses, non-technical courses such as Communicative English, *Penghayatan Etika dan Peradaban*, *Pengajian Islam*, and *Nilai Masyarakat Malaysia* is also being taught to enhance student's generic skills. Students will also be required to undergo a work-based learning at the industry which covers modular Front Store and Back Store Operations, Customer Service and Capstone Project.

The industry would certainly require skilled and competent personnel in order to promote its growth. This programme will produce a quality semi-professional graduates who will be part of the manpower in retail sector. Students will able to understand and analyse the current retail situations through project, problem scenario, case studies and other relevant assessments.
